Ammunition must be appropriate for rifle used (see "Classification" below). Tracer/Incendiary Ammunition is not allowed.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all competitors, membership in the NRA is NOT required.

FEES:

Colorado State Long Range Rifle Championship, two-day course of fire as specified below:

- CRC members \$50
- Non CRC members \$65

(includes NRA individual fee of \$9.00)

TIME OF FIRING: Firing will commence each day at 9:00 AM

TARGET: NRA Official Targets will be used (Section 4, NRA Rules).

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. (NRA Rule Book section 16).

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding will be done by the Statistical Office. Competitors are responsible for proof of classification. A competitor who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. **NRA classification cards may be checked by the Statistical Officer.** Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used.

Categories: The categories and rifles allowed for these matches are as follows:

- 1) Palma Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.3.1)
- 2) F- Open Rifle [NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.4(a)]
- 3) F- Target Rifle [NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.4(b)].
- 4) Any Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.2)

AWARDS FURNISHED BY COLORADO RIFLE CLUB

Award Schedule: Individual Grand Aggregate winners in the Palma, F-TR, F-Open, and Any Rifle categories will have their names engraved on the appropriate Colorado State High Power Rifle Long Range Trophies (provided entries warrant).

Cash prizes will be awarded for each 1000 yard match, and the Grand Aggregate, as warranted by entries.

Approximately fifty percent of the entry fees (minus NRA fees) will be returned to the competitors in the form of cash prizes.

COURSE OF FIRE

I. Long Range Prone:

(100 shot)

Day 1 Three 1,000 yd Individual Matches (*Rule 7.13*)

Day 2 Two 1,000 yd Individual Matches (*Rule 7.13*)

Matches 1 through 5 will be <u>unlimited</u> sighting shots and 20 shots for record in a time limit of 30 minutes. Match 6 is the aggregate of matches 1 through 5, and is the Colorado High Power Rifle State Championship.

Targets: Palma and Any Rifle: LR target, F-Class: LRFC target.

<u>Practice Day:</u> The range has been reserved for practice on Wednesday, 1 September 2020. This will be squadded practice, beginning at 9 AM. Practice is free for CRC members, \$5 range fee for non-members.

<u>Detail Duties:</u> Competitors will score and operate targets with the Colorado Rifle Club members performing match duties as assigned. Failure to serve your assigned detail (firing, scoring, and target duties) may result in disqualification for that match.
