

## 2024 CRC Garand, Springfield, Military Bolt Action, Modern Military (GSMM) 30 Shot Rifle Matches.

## Civilian Marksmanship Program Sanctioned Matches Sponsored by: The Colorado Rifle Club

MATCH DATES: GSMM match dates are <u>Saturday May 18</u>, <u>Saturday June 15</u>, <u>Saturday July 20</u>, <u>Saturday August 17</u>, <u>Saturday September 21</u>. Registration will begin at 08:00 AM. These are GSMM matches so that all classifications of CMP legal rifles are eligible. All As-issued rifle categories will be scored together. All unlimited categories may be scored separately if sufficient shooters attend. (Please reference CMP rules for rifle eligibility)

<u>LOCATION:</u> Colorado Rifle Club SCHUETZEN Rifle Range, 76099 East 96th Avenue, Byers, CO 80103. Byer is located about 45 miles east of Denver on I-70. The range is located about 8 miles east of Byers on U. S. 36, then about 9 miles north on Leader Road (52N). Then one mile west on 96th Ave. to the range gate, then one mile north to the ranges. (See map on information sheet or go to the club web site at <a href="www.crci.org">www.crci.org</a>. You can also Google or Bing this address for a map and aerial view. GPS also works on this address).

<u>ELIGIBILITY:</u> Any competitor 14 years of age or older and a citizen of the United States may enter this match. CMP rule 2.4 states that the age requirement may be waived by the match sponsor upon presentation of proof of the competitor's ability to handle a service rifle safely and complete the match course of fire.

ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted the morning of the match.

<u>Entries Limited To:</u> 50 competitors (two relays of 25 competitors each) with post entries accepted for squadding at the convenience of Match Officials provided no special squadding or relays are required.

<u>Match Fees:</u> \$20.00 per competitor for each day. **Make check or money order payable to:** <u>Colorado</u> <u>Rifle Club.</u>

<u>LIABILITY WAIVER:</u> An agreement of release and waiver of liability must be signed prior to the match. Competitors that will need to have a signed copy of the CMP waiver of liability and the CRC waiver on file each year. <u>RULES</u>: The current Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Competition Games Rules will govern the conduct of this match. <u>www.thecmp.org</u>

<u>AWARD SCHEDULE:</u> The awards will be based on As-Issued rifle classifications meeting the CMP Cut Scores and first through third places overall. Additional rifle categories in these matches may be recognized based on attendance.

<u>CMP RIFLE PURCHASE ELIGIBILITY</u>; The CMP Certificate of Competition (available upon successful completion) in one of these John C. Garand matches meets the CMP requirement for proof of marksmanship participation for purchasing rifles from the CMP. Go to <u>www.thecmp.org</u> or call 419-635-2141 for details.

<u>SAFETY:</u> Safety is paramount. Each shooter must provide eye and ear protection. Empty Chamber indicators must be used and may be borrowed for use at the match or purchased for \$1 each.

<u>COACHING:</u> Coaching of new shooters by experienced shooters is available and encouraged.

COURSE OF FIRE: The John C. Garand Match, Course "A" will be fired at 100 yards:

Stage 1: Slow fire prone: A maximum of 5 sighting shots in a time limit of 5 minutes.

Stage 2: Slow fire prone: 10 record shots in a time limit of 10 minutes

Stage 3: Rapid fire prone: 10 record shots in a time limit of 80 seconds. No alibis will be allowed. Coaching by looking through a spotting scope is not allowed.

Stage 4: Standing: 10 record shots in a time limit of 10 minutes.

TARGETS; The SR-1.

RIFLES; Each competitor should provide his or her rifle which, in accordance with CMP Games rules. The As-issued Rifles consist of M1 Garand, 1903 or 03-A3 Springfield, Vintage Bolt Action, Modern Military and M1 Carbine classes. These rifles are to be in the as-issued condition. In addition to the As-Issued classifications, we also encourage Unlimited class rifle and depending on participation will recognize separately. Reference the CMP rules for Unlimited rifle details. www.thecmp.org

AMMUNITION: Shooters is required to supply safe ammunition. Additionally, USGI cal. .30 (30-06) M2 ball or USGI cal..30 carbine ball ammunition is available for new shooters during registration for \$30 in addition to the entry fee. Shooters who purchase the surplus ammo are required to use this ammo during that day's match. No tracer or incendiary ammunition, etc. is allowed
