Sam writing to you in hopes of you granting me permission to hold the first inaugural MAT Fullbore F Glass Nationals Long Range at Colorado Rifle Glub in Byers, CO. As This is the first time its ever been held, Sam sure there will be some details to work out before its held like medals, but will be done well in advance.

Iwould like to hold the NRA Fullbore F Class Nationals July 19-21 2024. We just need a confirmation if we can or not no later than March 15th 2024. This will give us time to get the information out, match set, awards from vendors, medals made and the range ready.

The Colorado Rifle Club https://crci.org/isone of the largest Rifle Clubs in Colorado. It has a rich history of the shooting sports. We finished our 3000 sq ft clubhouse last year for banquets, meetings, awards etc... We have 35 RY spots with Electricity. Our dump station is operational for this year and water can be filled from numerous spots from our well.

Our Highpower Range consists of firing points at 300, 500, 600, 800, 900 and 1000 Yards. We am interested in holding the Long range portion of the Nationals, 800, 900 and 1000 yard. We have 21 firing points at each yardarge with ample parking spots. Our pits are the best in the USA. The pits are fully enclosed bunker with carriers that are smooth. We have included pictures of the pits and pictures of the range and facility can be found at the web link above.

The Colorado Rifle Club is well suited to hold this event as Matt Peetz, our match director, holds a State F Class match that is pair fire only and in two years he has gotten attendance up to 65 shooters.

Our State match is well known around the country. We are getting National Champions to come, numerous State and Regional winners as well, like Dan Bramley, David Gosnell, Norman Harrold, Doug Skogman, Luke Ramsey, Alton Johnson, Brad Suave, Emil Kovan, Tracy Harrold just to name a few.

Not only are High Caliber shooters in attendance, the prize table is one of the best in the nation. Our Vendors have stepped up and have made it great for the shooters. We know they will for this match also. We always have enough prizes for everyone in attendance. No one has gone home with nothing so far.

Byers, TO has a couple motels in town with a couple restaurants that is about 15 minutes from the range.

Bennet, TO has a newly built Comfort Inn and Suites with more food establishments and other accommodations. Bennet is about a 25-30 minute drive to the range.

Strasburg, TO has a KOA IT is about a 20 minuite drive to the range.

Multiple shooters that attend the State Match do VRBO around these towns.

Denver International Airport is about an Hour drive from the Range with easy access.

For the 2024 NRAFullbore F Class Nationals, it will be shot on manual targets. We can handle 120 shooters. This would be three relays.

We would have banquet for the shooters one day, Water will be provided for shooters every day. Daily medals will be given out after completion of firing at the clubhouse. The grand aggregate awards will be after final completion of the tournament in our clubhouse. Amedal list is being compiled and can be sent for approval. As this is the first National, we are hoping the list of medals will be used for all future Nationals.

Course of fire will follow the recently approved course of fire.

Day 1 - 3x800 plus a team match

Day 2-3x900 plus a team match

Day 3-3x1000 plus a team match

All matches will be fired two to a mound with two convertible sighters and 15 shots for record. Squadding will be all random and firing points and partners will change for every match. No one will be on the same firing point or have same partner all day.

The team match will be a four person team with each team member firing 15 shots.
